



WHA Match Day Protocols – Spectators

These protocols are designed to allow community hockey to happen safely under alert level 2 restrictions. It is important all our community help by 'doing the right thing' and ensuring these steps are undertaken to help protect against any potential spread of Covid-19. Please be aware of the specific venue site plan for where you are going to support.

On arrival – Enter through the entry point as indicated on the venue site map. Please check this prior to leaving for the turf. The updated venue site plans can be found on our website.

Contact Tracing – This is a requirement for all spectators coming to WHA venues. iDME is our sign in method at WHA venues (excluding Kapiti). Players and management will not be required to sign in via iDME.

Spectator Zones – these zones allow spectators to move freely and adjust viewing positions if required throughout a game. Please keep social distancing of 2m and respect those around you. Avoid leaning on or touching fence rails. Please respect all signage and the designated areas so we can comply with our H&S protocols and our requirements around distancing of people within our venues.

Player/Management/Official Zones – these zones allow players, management and officials to arrive prior to playing and congregate. These zones need to remain spectator free to ensure separate groups of 100 are defined.

Toilets – Are available at all venues excluding Elsdon.
